Pursuant to the authority delegated by the Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, under the County Environmental Health Act, (N.J.S.A. 26:3A2-21 et seq.), the Morris County Division of Public Health (MCDPH) enforces the provisions of the Solid Waste Management Act (N.J.S.A. 13:1E-1 et seq.) and Regulations (N.J.A.C. 7:26-1 and 7:26A-1 et seq.).







P.L. 2020, c. 117 Plastic Waste Law: Inspections

From May 4, 2022 to June 30, 2022 – Inspect at least 25 Food Service Businesses and 25 Grocery Stores for compliance with plastic, paper and polystyrene bans.

- "Food service business" means a business that sells or provides food for consumption on or off the premises, and includes, but is not limited to, any restaurant, café, delicatessen, coffee shop, convenience store, grocery store, vending truck or cart, food truck, movie theater, or business or institutional cafeteria, including those operated by or on behalf of any governmental entity.
- "Grocery store" means a self-service retail establishment that occupies <u>at least 2,500 square feet</u> and that sells household foodstuffs for off-site consumption, including, but not limited to, fresh produce, meat, poultry, fish, deli products, dairy products, canned foods, dry foods, beverages, baked foods, or prepared foods. "Grocery store" shall not include an establishment that handles only prepackaged food that does not require time or temperature controls for food safety.





P.L. 2020, c. 117 Plastic Waste Law: Enforcement

C.13:1E-99.131 Violations, penalties.

- First offense Notice of Violation (written warning, no penalty)
- Second offense Notice of Penalty (up to \$1,000)
- Third or subsequent offense Notice of Penalty (up to \$5,000)
- Penalties are collected through administrative hearings as established under the "Penalty Enforcement Law of 1999," P.L.1999, c.274 (C.2A:58-10 et seq.), or in any case before a court of competent jurisdiction wherein injunctive relief has been requested. If the violation is of a continuing nature, each day during which it continues shall constitute an additional, separate, and distinct offense. The Superior Court and the municipal court shall have jurisdiction to enforce the provisions of the "Penalty Enforcement Law of 1999" in connection with P.L.2020, c.117 (C.13:1E-99.126 et al.)
