Transfer Station News & Notes

Tipping Fees to Increase as of January 1, 2021 - Please be advised that starting on January 1, 2021 the tipping fees charged for the disposal of solid waste types at the MCMUA transfer stations will be increased by 1.75% or \$1.75/ton. The 2020 tipping fee of \$99.75/ton for the disposal of all waste types will be increased to \$101.50/ton. Please see the tipping fee chart below for details:
