WHEREAS, A-L Services, Inc. has submitted an application and has complied with all of the requirements of the Morris County Solid Waste Management Plan for blanket inclusion as a Class C Recycling Facility to the Morris County District Solid Waste Management Plan, a copy of which application is on file in the Office of the County Division of Solid Waste Management and notices of the proposed application have been appropriately published in the newspaper and notification to all property owners within two hundred (200) feet of the proposed facility has been effected by the applicant; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Morris as follows:

WHEREAS, no substantative objections to the site location were raised by the host community, the County Division of Solid Waste Management, the Morris County Solid Waste Advisory Council or any other person, company and/or entity.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Morris, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The aforementioned facility shall be deemed consistent with the Morris County Solid Waste Management Plan.
2. The application for the blanket inclusion in the Morris County District Solid Waste Management Plan as a Class C Recycling facility to the Morris County District Solid Waste Management Plan submitted by A-L Services, Inc. (see attached Exhibit A) be and is hereby approved.
3. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 13:1E-24D, the modifications of the application be and are hereby deemed to be minor and do not require subsequent action by the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Morris.
4. A certified copy of this resolution with an appropriate transmittal letter shall be sent to the Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection.
5. The within resolution shall take effect immediately.

Dear Mr. Director Murphy:

On March 3, 2003, the Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste received a Morris County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) amendment dated February 26, 2003. The plan amendment proposes County Plan inclusion of the A-L Services, Inc. Class C recycling facility, located at Block 266, Lots 3, 4 and 6, with a street address of 12 Taylor Road, Jefferson Township. The facility proposes to accept up to 5,000 cubic yards annually of vegetative waste for composting.

On March 10, 1993, the Morris County Board of Chosen Freeholders adopted an amendment to the County Plan, which was certified by the Department on July 25, 1993, that would allow the inclusion of Class C recycling facilities in the County Plan through a "blanket inclusion policy". Such a resolution can be made without a public hearing provided that there is no substantive written objection submitted during the comment period and provided that the applicant meets all other provisions of the blanket inclusion policy. The Plan Inclusion of the A-L Services, Inc. Class C recycling facility met the requirements of the Morris County blanket inclusion policy for the inclusion of Class C recycling facilities.

Furthermore, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)3, the inclusion of Class C recycling facilities in the County Plan through the "blanket inclusion policy" may be considered for approval through the administrative action process. Therefore, the Morris County plan amendment of February 26, 2003 is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).

The approval of this administrative action should not be construed as an approval by the Department to begin the proposed recycling activities at the facility. This activity shall be preceded by the acquisition of all necessary permits and approvals pursuant to N.J.S.A. 13:1E-1 et seq., and all other applicable laws.
