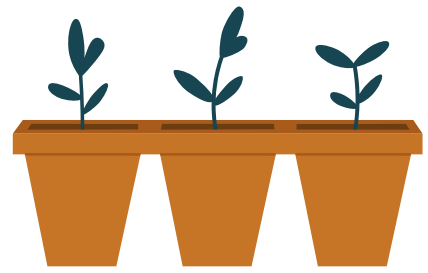
DID YOU KNOW...



While some plant pots and trays are made from plastic, they often contain dirt and plant matter that can contaminate recyclables.

While you may believe you're going green by recycling your used plant pots/trays, contamination diminishes the quality of the materials at the recycling facility.

SO WHAT CAN YOU DO WITH THEM?



- **Consider reusing pots/trays in your garden or even indoors**
- **Bring your empty pots/trays to a participating Lowe's or Home Depot garden center, where they can be recycled into new containers**
- **Call your local garden center to see if reuse options exist for your empty, clean pots/tray**
- **Contact your local garden club to see if they're accepting donations**
- **If reuse options aren't available, plant pots/trays can be thrown away in the regular garbage.**
