Dear Mr. Gindoff:

The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a proposed amendment to the Morris County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated July 27, 2017. This amendment to the County Plan proposes County Plan inclusion of the modification of capacity and an additional recyclable material accepted at the Northeast Products, LLC Class B Recycling Center located at 1405 Route 46 West (Block 8901; Lots 2 & 2.01) in the Township of Roxbury. The proposed amendment requests the inclusion of 125 tons per day of leaves from October to May, which includes spring cleanups. The leaves will be processed on-site for transport to a farm site approved to mulch the leaves into the soil.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)5, the modification of an existing recycling facility, including the acceptance of additional waste types, can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of the capacity increase and an additional recyclable material accepted at the Northeast Products, LLC Class B Recycling Center is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
